These Regulations prescribe the fees for the grant or renewal of licences under the Licensing (Jersey) Law 1974.

The effect is to increase all licence fees by approximately 2.5%.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 11 of the Licensing (Jersey) Law 1974, $^{[1]}$ as amended, have made the following Regulations -

1.-(1) Subject to paragraphs (2), (3), (4) and (5) of this Regulation, the fees payable on the grant or renewal o licences shall be as follows -

First Category £364 plus a fee of 90p multiplied by the maximum ("Taverner's licence") number of persons that may at any time be

accommodated for reward on the premises (hereinafter referred to as "the number of

approved residents")

Second Category A fee of 90p multiplied by the number of "Residential licence") approved residents, with a minimum fee of £113

Third Category £364

("Restaurant licence")

Fourth Category £908 plus a fee of £1.80 multiplied by the number

("Comprehensive of approved residents

licence")

Fifth Category £272 ("Club licence")

Sixth Category ("Off licence")

Seventh Category ("Entertainment licence")

(a) cinemas, theatres £364

(b) places of entertainment other than cinemas and A fee of 90p multiplied by the number of persons mentioned in the permit for entertainment granted by the Bailiff in respect of the premises, with a

theatres minimum fee of £364.

- (2) Where licences of different categories are applicable to the same premises, a separate fee shall be payable in respect of each category of licence.
- (3) Where a licence will expire within six months of its commencement, the fee for the licence shall be one half of that prescribed in paragraph (1) of this Regulation.
- (4) Where a licence will expire more than twelve months and seven days after its commencement, the fee for the licence shall be increased by one-twelfth.
- (5) Where an application for grant of a licence is refused or withdrawn, the amount of the fee shall be refunded to the applicant.
 - 2. The Licensing (Licence Fees) (Jersey) Regulations 1998^[2] shall be repealed.
- **3.** These Regulations may be cited as the Licensing (Licence Fees) (Jersey) Regulations 200- and shall come into force on the day following promulgation.
