“Could the Chief Minister confirm what, if any, consideration has been given to ascertaining whether Jersey citizens will be able to vote in the forthcoming referendum in the United Kingdom on membership of the European Union?”



2. Deputy J.A.N. Le Fondré of St. Lawrence will ask the following question of the Chief Minister –
“Could the Chief Minister provide an update as to when the Dame Heather Steel report will be released?”
3. Deputy S.Y. Mézec of St. Helier will ask the following question of the Minister for External Relations –
“What assurances, if any, have been given to the Jersey government by the United Kingdom government that Jersey’s position with regards to ‘Protocol 3’ will be safeguarded in the current renegotiation of the UK’s terms of membership with the European Union?”
4. Deputy R. Labey of St. Helier will ask the following question of the Minister for Economic Development –
“Would the Minister advise members what advice the Economic Development Department received in relation to the suitability of Condor Liberation for cross-Channel ferry operations and, in particular, detail what advice was received on the vessel’s seaworthiness and unique design and indicate who provided that advice?”
5. Deputy M. Tadier of St. Brelade will ask the following question of the Minister for Treasury and Resources –
“Will the Minister state whether there has been any consideration given, or any approaches made, with a view to making the disused swimming pool area at Fort Regent into a temporary skate park; if not, why not and, if so, will the Minister give details?”
6. Senator Z.A. Cameron will ask the following question of the Minister for Health and Social Services –
“Had any of the GPs investigated by the Primary Care Governance Team raised concerns about the management of patients by the department prior to receiving a complaint made against them by an employee from the Health and Social Services department?”
7. Deputy L.M.C. Doublet of St. Saviour will ask the following question of the Minister for Treasury and Resources –
“Can the Minister advise whether any discussions have been held and/or decisions taken place regarding possible future uses for the current Police headquarters site at Rouge Bouillon and give details of these, given the forthcoming relocation of Police headquarters to Green Street?”
8. Deputy G.P. Southern of St. Helier will ask the following question of the Chief Minister –
“Does the Chief Minister believe that the figure of £60.34 (£59.16 plus 2%) derived from Table 8 of the Living Wage Number Report is sufficient to feed a couple in Jersey for a week?”
9. Deputy J.A.N. Le Fondré of St. Lawrence will ask the following question of the Minister for Treasury and Resources –
“Why has the Minister not complied with his spoken undertaking to the States Assembly and his written undertaking to the Corporate Services Scrutiny Panel that the Panel would receive an un-redacted copy of the BNP Paribas appraisal under the confidentiality terms laid out in his letter of 28th April and to which the Panel readily, and expeditiously, agreed?”



10. Deputy M. Tadier of St. Brelade will ask the following question of the Minister for Planning and Environment –

“Will the Minister advise whether there are any plans to optimise the use of photovoltaics in Jersey and, in particular, on States owned buildings, and what steps, if any, he is taking to encourage their general usage where appropriate?”

11. Deputy G.P. Southern of St. Helier will ask the following question of the Chief Minister –

“What economic impact assessment has the Chief Minister carried out on the effect of the removal of some £125 million (19% of revenue expenditure) from the economy by a combination of redundancies, wage freezes, benefit cuts and user-pays and other charges, especially on low and middle income households; will he publish the assessment and, if no such assessment has been carried out, when will he undertake such research?”

12. Senator Z.A. Cameron will ask the following question of the Minister for Health and Social Services –

“What process was used to assess whether complaints made against GPs were of sufficient severity and concern to warrant investigation by the Primary Care Governance Team?”

13. Deputy S.Y. Mézec of St. Helier will ask the following question of the Minister for Transport and Technical Services –

“What details, if any, can the Minister give of the government’s plans to introduce a new user-pays charge for waste disposal?”

- (c) give an undertaking to instruct the States of Jersey Development Company not to take any further steps to progress the development until the results of his financial assessment have been presented either to members or, if the data is confidential, to the Corporate Services scrutiny panel?”
