enough to venture into town.
Lloyds Bank was nearby, with parking
& friendly staff - who were always
able to help with banking and
investments.

A recent scam phone call meant I had to rush to Bank - (At Quemeccis) to confirm my funds were safe. Not possible - if I have to travel into Howson.

What about cash? Takeaways use the ATM - I use cash.

Spent £10 last week at 3 hedge stalls in St Howson.
How are we supposed to support our mess if we don't have cash.

As you can see I am an elderly (~~75~~) St Brevalde resident who has no knowledge of computers, and would be at a disadvantage with loss of Logdo Bank at Quemeccis.
