## Report

The Executive Committee of the Assemblée Internationale de Parlementaires de Langue Française was last formally constituted in 1985 by the States on the proposition of the former Senator R. Vibert, who, while remaining a member of the Executive Committee, retired as Chairman at that time. Due to an oversight, the constitution has not been amended since then, and for this reason I am proposing the revised constitution of the Executive Committee.

The Executive Committee currently comprises myself, Senator Pierre François Horsfall, Mrs. Iris Medora Le Feuvre, Connétable of St. Lawrence and Mrs. Enid Clare Quenault, Connétable of St.Brelade. The Connétables of St. John and St. Ouen and Deputy Jeremy Laurence Dorey will bring the Executive Committee up to full strength, and I recommend the States to approve the proposals before it.
