## DRAFT HARBOURS (AMENDMENT No. 38)(JERSEY) REGULATIONS 200-

#### **REPORT**

In order to make best use of open space for working and moving items through the Harbours, there is a system of Quay Inspection which, where items stay beyond a prescribed free period, a daily fine is imposed.

In order to maintain the effectiveness of this sanction it is proposed that the fines be increased by 4.8% (Jersey Retail Price Index). Based on the current fines income this would be an additional £531 p.a.

#### **Explanatory Note**

The effect of these Regulations would be to increase by 4.8 per cent the daily charges for goods that remain on a harbour for longer than the period specified in Part 1 of the First Schedule to the Harbours (Jersey) Regulations 1962.

The Regulations would come into force on 1st January 2005.

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of Article 4 of the Harbours (Administration) (Jersey) Law 1961, <sup>[1]</sup> have made the following Regulations –

#### 1 First Schedule amended

For Part 2 of the First Schedule to the Harbours (Jersey) Regulations  $1962^{[2]}$  there shall be substituted the Part set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

#### 2 Citation and commencement

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Harbours (Amendment No. 38) (Jersey) Regulations 200.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on 1st January 2005.
