DRAFT HARBOURS (AMENDMENT No. 38)(JERSEY) REGULATIONS 200-

REPORT

In order to make best use of open space for working and moving items through the Harbours, there is a system of Quay Inspection which, where items stay beyond a prescribed free period, a daily fine is imposed.

In order to maintain the effectiveness of this sanction it is proposed that the fines be increased by 4.8% (Jersey Retail Price Index). Based on the current fines income this would be an additional £531 p.a.

Explanatory Note

The effect of these Regulations would be to increase by 4.8 per cent the daily charges for goods that remain on a harbour for longer than the period specified in Part 1 of the First Schedule to the Harbours (Jersey) Regulations 1962.

The Regulations would come into force on 1st January 2005.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 4 of the Harbours (Administration) (Jersey) Law 1961, ^[1] have made the following Regulations –

1 First Schedule amended

For Part 2 of the First Schedule to the Harbours (Jersey) Regulations 1962^[2] there shall be substituted the Part set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

2 Citation and commencement

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Harbours (Amendment No. 38) (Jersey) Regulations 200.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on 1st January 2005.

NEW PART 2 TO FIRST SCHEDULE

“PART 2

CHARGES FOR GOODS REMAINING ON A HARBOUR LONGER THAN THE PERIOD SPECIFIED IN PART 1 OF THIS SCHEDULE

<i>Description of goods</i>	<i>Daily charge</i>
1. Flats, trailers, containers and equipment:	
Not more than 3 metres long	£13.05
More than 3 metres long but not more than 6 metres long	£26.10
More than 6 metres long but not more than 7 metres long	£30.44
More than 7 metres long but not more than 8 metres long	£34.79
More than 8 metres long but not more than 10 metres long	£43.49
More than 10 metres long but not more than 12 metres long	£52.19
More than 12 metres long	£59.15
2. Vehicles	£10.72
3. All other goods	£17.85 for every 10 square metres of space or part thereof occupied by such goods”.
