The Employers' Side membership comprises 4 representatives of the States and one representative of the Connétables.

The Employers' Side represents the Executive in negotiations with the Unite (Transport and General Workers' section) Union on Manual Workers' pay and conditions of service. The nominations for the States' representatives have been based on the fact that they are Assistant Ministers or Chief Officers of departments employing significant numbers of manual workers.
