## **REPORT**

This amendment is designed to maintain the status quo with respect to the level of fees for actions in the Petty Debts Court.

Maintaining the fees at their current level will result in a reduction of £120,000 in the additional income generated by the Regulations.

There are no manpower implications for the States arising from this draft Amendment.
