Dear Deputy Jeune,

Thank you for your letter dated 4 March 2024 regarding updating the panel about Ministerial Priorities prior to the briefing on 27 March 2024.

Please find below a number of priorities that have been identified:

- Address under-investment in government-owned property; tackle the widening gap in the condition of the estate and the maintenance funding – need a sustainable funding model; look for solution for Fort Regent
- 2. Promote access to town via strategies for walking, cycling, bus travel, promoting specific projects, and seeking opportunities for greater accessibility to parking spaces for Islanders and tourists alike
- 3. Promote the hopper bus in particular and bus use in general, particularly a circular bus route across the northern parishes (noting the presence of the Enid Quenault Centre at Les Quennevais)
- 4. Pursue liquid waste projects to support the delivery of new housing across the Island and ensure sufficient capacity for the longer term
- 5. Examine use of the school sports estate for wider community use and examine possibility of a central booking system combining Infrastructure-run sports facilities with school facilities

- 6. Continue developing the Markets and Lido at Havre de Pas, working with the Constable of St Helier who is now the Assistant Minister for Infrastructure
- 7. Look to host the Island Games in 2031 or 2033
- 8. Move forward with plans for satellite skate parks in town/east of the Island.

I hope the above is helpful and look forward to meeting with you all at the briefing.
