	<b>Future of Education Green Paper</b>  The Panel having considered the draft Green Paper and the briefing from the Minister for Education Sport and Culture on the same agreed to write to the Minister expressing disappointment in the lack of analysis of future options for the education system. Members agreed that it would not be appropriate to review the Green Paper but would await to see how the Department responded to the public consultation.
