R&O 46/2004.

The purpose of this Order is to designate René Le Bail House in La Route de Saint Aubin, St. Helier, to be a site of special interest by reason of the special architectural and historical interests that attach to it.

Article 1 describes the proposed site and the special interests that attach to it.
