Briefing Paper: Update on Rural Economy Strategy

The Rural Economy Strategy (RES) was implemented on 1st January 2006 and is currently due to end on the 1st December 2010. The Strategy document gave a clear undertaking that the RES 2005 would be reviewed in 2009 with the objective of bringing forward a new 5 year Rural Economy Strategy for 2011 to 2015. [1]

Following a meeting with Dan Houseago, Assistant Director, Environmental Management and Rural Economy an update of progression of the new Rural Economy Strategy is as follows:

The timetable for the Rural Economy Strategy (RES) review is approximately as follows however if agreement on a new policy can be reached sooner a replacement policy can be implemented at an earlier date.
