Under Article 14 of the Public Records (Jersey) Law 2002, the Minister for Education, Sport and Culture is responsible for the appointment of 5 people to serve on the Records Advisory Panel and for advising the States of those appointments. The Minister is also responsible under Article 14 of the Law for appointing a Chairman from the members of the Panel.

The terms of office of the current Records Advisory Panel expire on 11th December 2015. Following an open appointments process, involving advertising of the forthcoming vacancies and formal interviews, the Minister for Education, Sport and Culture has appointed the following 5 people to serve as members of the Records Advisory Panel –

Mr. J.M.E. Harris (Chairman) Miss M.M. Billot Mr. M.C. Sunier Mrs. M-L. Backhurst Mrs. A.H. Harris.

Miss M.M. Billot and Mr. M.C. Sunier are existing members, and have offered their services for a second term not exceeding 6 years, as prescribed by paragraph 1(2) of Schedule 2 of the Law. The Minister has also appointed Mr. J.M.E. Harris as Chairman, upon the recommendation of the interviewing panel.
