Criminal Justice Policy – audit of the need for a prosecution service – P. 161/2007

- (b) no consideration by the States of paragraph (b) of the Criminal Justice Policy lodged “au Greffe” by the Minister on 4th September 2007 should take place until the Minister had presented the findings of the independent audit to the States.
