It was noted that there were few changes from the preceding year. However, the Solid Waste Strategy had been amended to include the phrase 'subject to environmental taxes'. Members felt that this undermined the consultation exercise that was just coming to an end.

Members considered that the apparent intent to build new car parks was inconsistent with the demands of sustainability; however full details of the revised plans were not yet available.
