PAGE 13, ARTICLE 1 –

For the words “first entered into in 1952 between His Majesty King George V’s
Government” substitute the words –

“entered into in 1952 between Her Majesty’s Government”.

REPORT

The reference to His Majesty King George V in P.51/2016 is incorrect, as it was His Majesty King George VI who was on the throne in 1952. By the time the States adopted the Double Taxation Relief (Arrangement with the United Kingdom) (Jersey) Act 1952 in March 1952, Her Majesty the Queen had just recently acceded to the throne.

This proposed amendment corrects the error.
