REPORT

The terms of the delegations, and the legislation under which those delegations were made, were recorded in a Report attached to the Ministerial Decision, as shown below –

Delegate:	Assistant Minister for Education and Lifelong Learning, Connétable Richard Vibert
Functions delegated:	Article 3(1)(a)(ii) to recommend persons for Management Board membership to the Chief Minister
Scope of delegation:	Full delegation in respect of the above areas. This includes the authority to sign ministerial decisions in respect of these areas and in respect of any provisions included in any relevant legislation.
