Rural Economy Strategy

Thank you for your letter of 13th April 2010 requesting comments on the Strategy.

I will comment on Issues and Policy Options PE6 and PE7, which are within my area of expertise.

I believe that the issues and policy options are the correct ones. I suggest that the correct body to pursue policy option 6 is Skills Jersey who have the remit to identify skills gaps.

The issue of how to address the skills gaps is likely to be a problematic area as the training and expertise for vocational development is largely lacking in the Island and is unlikely to attract sufficient people to make on-Island delivery practical or affordable.

The solution might be to establish a link with a UK agricultural college, probably in the south-west who will be prepared to do some work on-Island. Such colleges are now highly specialist and provide a very wide range of programmes in agriculture, horticulture, country side management, sports and golf, and rural economy skills.

Highlands has links with a number of colleges through its University of Plymouth partnership and will happy to broker these discussions.
