1 **PAGE 9, ARTICLE 1(1)(b)** –

For the words "of the fact" substitute the words "or equivalent (if any) giving the fact".

2 PAGE 9, ARTICLE 1(2)(b)(ii) -

For the words "medical certificate" substitute the words "medical certificate or equivalent (if any)".

REPORT

Overview

The Minister for Economic Development lodged the Draft Aircraft Registration (Births, Deaths and Missing Persons) (Jersey) Regulations 201- (P.63/2015) (the "draft Regulations"). Subsequently, the Acting Viscount, who is also the Chief Coroner for the Government of Jersey, raised a number of points with regard to the draft Regulations that require amendments.

Proposed Amendments

Medical Certificate in the case of a death

It has been brought to the attention of the Economic Development Department that not all jurisdictions provide a medical certificate of the fact and cause of death. It has also been noted that the document providing the requisite information may not be called a 'medical certificate' and hence amendments are required in the draft Regulations to rectify this.

Article 1(1)(b) states:

"in the case of a death, a medical certificate of the fact and cause of death in the form approved by the Superintendent Registrar"

To remedy this issue the following words will be added to the Article "... certificate [or equivalent (if any) giving] the fact"

Further Article 1(2)(b)(ii) states:

"in the case of a death, the medical certificate mentioned in paragraph (1)(b).

And this will be further rectified by:

"...certificate [or equivalent (if any)] mentioned ..."

Financial and manpower implications

There are no further manpower or financial resource implications by introducing this amendment.
