Possible breaches of parliamentary privilege. 1240/12 (10)

A1. The Committee, with reference to its Minute No. B1 of 27th March 2009, considered a draft Report in connexion with parliamentary privilege.

The Committee recalled that a matter of privilege had been raised by the Chairman on 3rd February 2009 following the publication in the Jersey Evening Post and by Senator S. Syvret of certain details of an *in camera* debate that had been held on 21st January 2009. The Committee recalled that it had discussed the matter with the Bailiff as President of the States at its meeting of 27th February 2009, and had researched the position in other jurisdictions.
