- 1. Please explain how you work with the Government of Jersey to support your organisation?
 - CIFO is independent of the GoJ, GFSC and other stakeholders
 - CIFO Board Directors are appointed by the Minister EDTSC on recommendation of CIFO Chair
 - CIFO Chair appointed by the Minister EDTSC
 - Day-to-day interaction between CIFO management and GoJ is through a senior officer within the Office of the Chief Executive, Financial Services and Digital Economy
- 2. What would improve both your relationship, and the level of support you receive?
 - No issues of note
- 3. Have you noticed any changes to your relationship with the Government of Jersey since the introduction of Target Operating Models and/or the Jersey Performance Framework in 2018?
 - No change in relationship noted
 - CIFO point of contact shifted to current GoJ unit from former Economic Development unit (involved a change of designated point of contact staff officer as well)
- 4. If you had any complaints or issues, how did you raise it, what was the outcome, and were you satisfied?
 - No complaints or issues
 - Numerous ongoing workstreams to refine CIFO's legislative and operating framework
 - Synchronising GoJ views with those of Guernsey counterparts has raised occasional issues to overcome; handled reasonably
