Under the Gambling (Betting) (Jersey) Regulations 1965, as amended, a bookmaker's occasional licence is solely used at the Race Club meetings at Les Landes by non-residents. Two such licences are currently in force. The proposed increase is as follows -

a bookmaker's occasional licence from £90 per day to £96.75 per day.

The deposit for a licence will remain at £250.

These Regulations have no implications for the financial or manpower resources of the States. The increases are in accordance with the agreed policy of the Finance and Economics Committee.

Explanatory Note

The purpose of these draft Regulations is to increase the fee payable in respect of the grant of a bookmaker's occa	sional
licence from £90 to £96.75 for each day for which the licence is to be granted. The fee was last increased in 1997.

GAMBLING (BETTING) (AMENDMENT No. 11) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 2000

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 3 of the Gambling (Jersey) Law 1964, $^{[1]}$ as amended, have made the following Regulations -

- 1. In the First Schedule to the Gambling (Betting) (Jersey) Regulations 1965, as amended, [2] in paragraph 2(a), for the amount "£90" there shall be substituted the amount "£96.75".
 - 2. The Gambling (Betting) (Amendment No. 10) (Jersey) Regulations 1997 shall be repealed.
- **3.** These Regulations may be cited as the Gambling (Betting) (Amendment No. 11) (Jersey) Regulations 2000 and shall come into force on the first day of January 2001.
