## **DRAFT HEALTH CARE (REGISTRATION) (No. 2) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 200-**

### **REPORT**

---

The consequence of the Regulations is to register the occupation of specialist community public health nurse and prohibit a person from undertaking the functions of a specialist community public health nurse or to hold himself or herself out as a nurse of that description unless registered as such under the Health Care (Registration) (Jersey) Law 1995.

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States arising from these draft Regulations.

## **Explanatory Note**

---

The effect of these Regulations, if made, would be to prohibit a person from undertaking the functions of a specialist community public health nurse or to hold himself or herself out as a nurse of that description unless registered as such under the Health Care (Registration) (Jersey) Law 1995.

The Regulations would come into force on 1st July 2005.

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of Article 17 of the Health Care Registration (Jersey) Law 1995,<sup>[1]</sup> have made the following Regulations –

### **1 Schedule amended**

In the Health Care (Registration) (Jersey) Law 1995, in the Schedule,<sup>[2]</sup> after the entry “Radiographer” there shall be inserted the entry “Specialist community public health nurse”.

### **2 Citation and commencement**

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Care (Registration) (No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations 200-.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force on 1st July 2005.
