Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Law is to authorize the making and levying of rates in the parishes for the years 1999 and 2000.

PARISH RATE (JERSEY) LAW 199

A LAW to authorize the levy of rate in the parishes of the Island for two years; sanctioned by Order of Her Majesty in Council of the

THE STATES, subject to the sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, have adopted the following Law -

ARTICLE 1

A foncier rate and an occupier's rate are hereby authorized to be made and levied in the parishes of the Island for the years nineteen hundred and ninety-nine and two thousand, in accordance with the Parish Rate (Administration) (Jersey) Law 1946, as amended'.

ARTICLE 2

This Law may be cited as the Parish Rate (Jersey) Law 199.
