### **Explanatory Note**

These Regulations will amend Article 32B(3) of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956 to increase the maximum fine that may be imposed by an Order made in respect of parking places for an offence under the Order from £100 to level 2 on the standard scale (presently £500).

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the Order in Council of the twenty-sixth day of December 1851<sup>[1]</sup> and Article 49 of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956, as amended,<sup>[2]</sup> have made the following Regulations -

1. In paragraph (3) of Article 32B of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956, as amended,<sup>[3]</sup> for the words “a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds” there shall be substituted the words “a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale<sup>[4]</sup>”.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (No. 51) (Jersey) Regulations 200 and shall come into force on the first day of March 2001.
