## **REPORT**

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The current regulation defines Sole as *Solea solea* and specifies a minimum size of 24 c.m. The amendment seek to broaden the definition of Sole to *Solea spp* to include other members of the Sole species and is consistent with U.K. legislation for the English Channel.

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States arising from these draft Regulations.

## **Explanatory Note**

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These Regulations widen the definition of sole for the purposes of the minimum size of fish that may be retained.

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of Articles 2, 6 and 8 of the Sea Fisheries (Jersey) Law 1994,<sup>[1]</sup> having consulted with the Secretary of State and obtained the Secretary's concurrence, have made the following Regulations –

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### **1 Schedule amended**

In Column 1 of Part 1 of the Schedule to the Sea Fisheries (Minimum Size Limits) (Jersey) Regulations 2001<sup>[2]</sup> for “Sole (*Solea vulgaris*)” there shall be substituted “Sole (*Solea spp*)”.

### **2 Citation and commencement**

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Sea Fisheries (Minimum Size Limits) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations 200-
- (2) They shall come into force 7 days after they are made.
