DRAFT POLICING OF PARKS (AMENDMENT No. 14)(JERSEY) REGULATIONS 200

REPORT

To improve the management and regulation of the Island's parks and open spaces it has become necessary to amend the Policing of Parks (Jersey) Regulations 1962 to include new areas of land and also to include changes which will enable boats and boating equipment placed in parks to be removed.

The attached document therefore updates and replaces the current Policing of Parks (Jersey) Regulations.

The adoption of these amendments to the Regulations has no financial or manpower implications for the States.

Explanatory Note

These Regulations amend the Policing of Parks (Jersey) Regulations 1962 –

- (a) to require owners of boats to obtain permission before they leave their boats (and boating equipment) in parks;
- (b) to allow boats and boating equipment left in parks without that permission to be removed in the same way as vehicles left in parks without permission can be removed;
- (c) to designate as parks 2 areas where dogs may be exercised off a lead; and
- (d) to designate as parks 2 areas where dogs may be exercised off a lead and where horses may be ridden on roads and riding ways.

THE STATES, in pursuance of the Order in Council dated 26th December 1851,^[1] Article 49 of the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956,^[2] and the Policing of Roads, Parks and Sea Beaches (Application of Fines) (Jersey) Law 1957,^[3] have made the following Regulations –

1 Interpretation

In these Regulations “the principal Regulations” means the Policing of Parks (Jersey) Regulations 1962.^[4]

2 Regulation 4 amended

Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations shall be amended –

(a) by adding at the end of paragraph (1) the following sub-paragraph –

“(j) allow to remain at rest or store a boat or a trailer, gear, equipment, tackle or other apparatus associated with a boat.”;

(b) by adding after paragraph (2) the following paragraph –

“(3) An authorized person has the same power to remove anything allowed to remain at rest or stored in a park contrary to paragraph (1)(j) as the person has to remove a vehicle from the park pursuant to the Road Traffic (Removal of Vehicles) (Jersey) Order 1963.^[5]”.

3 Schedule amended

The Schedule to the principal Regulations 1962 shall be amended–

(a) by adding after the existing entries in Part III the following entries –

“The land situated seaward of the granite wall on the La Commune De Haut and south of the fence marking the southern boundary of Portelet House.

The land situated inland of the seawall in Ouaisné Bay including Field number 614 (La Mielle Ouaisné).”;

(b) by adding after the existing entries in Part IV the following entries –

“The area of land known as Les Creux Millenium Country Park situated above and to the north and west of Beauport Beach.

An area of wetland known as La Reste du Côté des Vaux situated above the woodland at Egypte and south west of La Pierre de la Fételle.”.

4 Citation and commencement

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Policing of Parks (Amendment No. 14) (Jersey) Regulations 200-.
- (2) They shall come into force 7 days after they are made.
