Licensing law</p> <p>The Panel noted that agreement had been reached with the Shadow Alcohol and Licensing Policy Group (SALPG) that the debate on the draft law would be delayed until 16th January 2018. The States Assembly website was now showing the date as 28th November, but it was assumed that this was the last date on which the debate could be held without the Proposition being re-lodged.
