#### Report

This amendment should be fairly self-explanatory: Article 32 confers considerable powers (listed in paragraph 3) on a designated officer, to enter premises and carry out actions to investigate the possibility of pollution. The amendment is simply a balancing provision, requiring the officer to inform the owner, householder etc. of all such actions, in writing and within a reasonable period of time.

#### PAGE 57, ARTICLE 32 -

Insert after paragraph (6) the following paragraph -

"(7) Where a designated officer has exercised any powers under this Article in respect of any land, vehicle, vessel, hovercraft or aircraft, he shall in writing inform the owner, occupier, driver, master, commander, or person in charge (as the case may be) as soon as reasonably practicable and in any event within 21 days -

(a) of the powers he has so exercised; and

(b) of everything he has taken or removed in the course of exercising those powers.".
