## Report

The report accompanying these draft Regulations covers three sets of draft Regulations and is printed in P.72/2002 (Draft Gambling (Betting) (Amendment No. 13) (Jersey) Regulations 200).

## **Explanatory Note**

The draft Regulations amend the Gambling (Pool Betting) (Jersey) Regulations 1965 by providing that Tote betting shall not be unlawful gambling if such bets are made in accordance with the Gambling (Betting) (Jersey) Regulations 1975 and with the holder of a betting office or credit betting office licence.

**THE STATES,** in pursuance of Article 3 of the Gambling (Jersey) Law 1964, [1] as amended, have made the following Regulations -

- 1. Regulation 2(1) of the Gambling (Pool Betting) (Jersey) Regulations 1965, as amended  $\frac{[2]}{}$  shall be amended -
- (a) by revoking the word "or" at the end of sub-paragraph (a);
- (b) by adding the word "or" at the end of sub-paragraph (b); and
- (c) by adding the following sub-paragraphs after sub-paragraph (b) -
  - "(c) the holder of a betting office licence or a credit betting office licence issued in accordance with the provisions of the Gambling (Licensing Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations, 1965, as amended, by means of facilities provided in accordance with section 14 of the United Kingdom Act, by or on behalf of the Totalisator Board, or by persons authorized by the Totalisator Board and having the management of an approved horse racecourse.
  - (d) In this regulation -

'the United Kingdom Act' means the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act, 1963, of the United Kingdom;

'Totalisator Board' means the Horserace Totalisator Board established by section 12 of the United Kingdom Act; and

'approved horse racecourse' means any ground in respect of which there is for the time being in force a certificate of approval of that ground as a horse racecourse issued under section 13 of the United Kingdom Act by the Horserace Betting Levy Board established by section 24 of the United Kingdom Act."

**2.** These Regulations may be cited as the Gambling (Pool Betting) (Amendment No. 2) (Jersey) Regulations 200- and shall come into force on the day following promulgation.
