THE STATES, having been informed that the relevant scrutiny panel had indicated that it did not wish to scrutinise the draft legislation, adopted Regulations 1 to 4 and the Schedule.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Articles 5 and 18 of the Income Support (Jersey) Law 200, made Regulations entitled the Income Support (Amendment No. 5) (Jersey) Regulations 2010.

THE STATES noted that, in accordance with the provisions of Standing Order 106(1)(a), Deputy Andrew Kenneth Francis Green of St. Helier declared an interest and withdrew from the Chamber for the duration of the debate.

### **Adjournment**

THE STATES adjourned, having agreed to reconvene on Wednesday 21st July 2010 to consider the outstanding items of public business.
