REPORT

The Public Finances (Jersey) Law 2005 (Appointed Day No. 1) Act 2005 brought into force certain Articles of the Law to enable the appointment of a Comptroller and Auditor General.

This second Appointed Day Act will bring into effect the remaining Articles of the Public Finances (Jersey) Law 2005 at the same time as the Committees of the States are abolished following the appointment of a Council of Ministers.

Financial and manpower statement

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States arising from this draft Act.

Explanatory Note

The Public Finances (Jersey) Law 2005 (Appointed Day No. 1) Act 2005 brought into force Articles 1, 40-45, 69, and 71-74 of the Public Finances (Jersey) Law 2005 so that a Comptroller and Auditor General could be appointed.

This Act will bring into force the remainder of the Law at the same time as the Committees of the States are abolished following the appointment of a Council of Ministers.

1 Commencement of remaining provisions of the Public Finances (Jersey) Law 2005

The remaining provisions of the Public Finances (Jersey) Law 2005 (being those provisions not brought into force by the Public Finances (Jersey) Law 2005 (Appointed Day No. 1) Act 2005)^[2] shall come into force on the same day as Article 42(3) of the States of Jersey Law 2005.^[3]
