## **REPORT**

Minor changes are required to the form used to gather information from households to prepare the electoral register following the amendments made to the Law by the Public Elections (Amendment No. 3) (Jersey) Law 2008.

There are no financial or manpower implications for the States arising from these Draft Regulations.

## **Explanatory Note**

---

The purpose of these Regulations is to change a cross-reference in the Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations 2002 and to make minor changes to the form used for verifying and gathering the information needed from households in order to prepare the electoral registers for Jersey.

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of Articles 7 and 72 of the Public Elections (Jersey) Law 2002<sup>[1]</sup>, have made the following Regulations –

---

### **1 Regulation 2 amended**

For Regulation 2(1A) of the Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations 2002<sup>[2]</sup> there shall be substituted the following paragraph –

“(1A) For the purposes of Article 7(2)(a) of the Law, the prescribed form of statement is Form 1A.”.

### **2 Form 1A substituted**

For Form 1A in the Schedule to the Public Elections (Jersey) Regulations 2002 there shall be substituted the form set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

### **3 Citation and commencement**

- (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Public Elections (Amendment No. 3) (Jersey) Regulations 200-.
- (2) These Regulations shall come into force 7 days after they are made.



**COLUMN 3 Period of Ordinary Residence**

Please enter A or B as follows (if both A and B apply it is sufficient to state A) -

the letter **A** if you have been ordinarily resident in Jersey for a period of at least 2 years up to and including the day when you sign this form; or

the letter **B** if you have been ordinarily resident in Jersey for a period of at least 6 months up to and including the day when you sign this form, as well as having been ordinarily resident in Jersey at any time for an additional period of, or for additional periods that total, at least 5 years.

**COLUMN 5 Occupation**

Completion of this box is optional, but can help to exclude some persons from jury service.
