Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Act is to change the name of the Defence Committee to the Home Affairs Committee.

The change of name will take effect on 9th December 1999.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 29 of the States of Jersey Law 1966,¹ as amended, have made the following Act -

1. The name of the Defence Committee is changed to the Home Affairs Committee.

2.-(1) In the construction of, and for the purposes of, any enactment, judgment, award, contract, certificate or other document passed or made before the coming into force of this Act, anything which is, or is to be construed as, a reference to the Defence Committee or its officers shall be construed as a reference to the Home Affairs Committee or its officers.

(2) Nothing in paragraph (1) of this Article shall be construed as affecting the title of any enactment.

3. This Act may be cited as the Defence Committee (Change of Name) (Jersey) Act 199 and shall come into force on the ninth day of December 1999.
