DRAFT HEALTH CARE (REGISTRATION) (JERSEY) REGULATIONS 200-

REPORT

The effect of the Regulations would be to amend the list of registrable occupations by inserting “Registered nurse: first level” and “Registered nurse: second level” in the schedule of registered occupations.

The effect of the Order is to prescribe qualifications for registration as a nurse: first level, or a registered nurse: second level; if registered in the equivalent occupation under the Nursing and Midwifery Order 2001 of the United Kingdom.

There are no additional financial or manpower implications for the States arising from these Draft Regulations.

Explanatory Note

These Regulations insert into the list of registrable occupations “Registered nurse: first level” and “Registered nurse: second level”. The Regulations shall come into force 7 days after they are made.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 17 of the Health Care (Registration) (Jersey) Law 1995^[1], have made the following Regulations –

1 Schedule amended

In the Schedule to the Health Care (Registration) (Jersey) Law 1995, after the entry “Radiographer” there shall be inserted the following entries –

“Registered nurse: first level

Registered nurse: second level”.

2 Citation and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Health Care (Registration) (Jersey) Regulations 200- and shall come into force 7 days after they are made.
