Channel Islands Lottery: Allocation of Proceeds from 2020 P.53/2021

- 40% of the allocation to arts, culture and heritage;
- 40% of the allocation to sports and active lifestyle; and
- 20% of the allocation to applied science or applied research in the fields of engineering, biology, ecology, physics, chemistry or mathematics provided that the funds are either to be used locally or for the direct benefit of Jersey, including any education from which local residents may benefit;

(c) to note and approve the proposal that, out of the allocation of the funds referred to in paragraph (b) above, each of the Association of Jersey Charities and the Jersey Community Foundation shall be entitled to cover its reasonable costs for undertaking its work involved in

distribution of such funds with Service Level Agreements (SLAs) to be entered into by those organisations providing that such costs amount to no more than 10% of the total sums received and that any underspend at the end of 2021 be added to the amounts available for distribution;

- (d) to request the Minister for Economic Development, Tourism, Sport and Culture to present the S.L.A.s referred to in paragraph (c) to the States and to make copies available via the Government website”.
