Report

Le Geyt Centre at Five Oaks was built as an Adult Training Centre for people with learning difficulties. The Centre was built using an early timber frame form type of construction in the 1970s. Due to poor design, the building has deteriorated rapidly, with ingress of water causing the wooden frame to rot in many places.

Funding for the refurbishment of Le Geyt Centre was approved in the Health and Social Services Capital Plan for 1997. Due to the poor condition of the existing structure, a scheme has now been designed that allows for the rebuilding of the worst part of the building, without the need to seek additional funding other than inflation on the original sum.

During the reconstruction and refurbishment work, the users of Le Geyt Centre will be decanted to other facilities, apart from the gardening section who will remain on site, where temporary facilities are being provided for their safe welfare.
