Health and Safety Appeal Tribunal: re-appointment of Chairman P.25/2014

Draft Passports (False Statements and Forgery) (Jersey) Law 201- P.14/2014

- (d) in sub-paragraphs (2)(a) and (2)(c), the words "or recklessly" should be omitted.
