THE STATES commenced consideration of paragraph (a)(v) of the proposition requesting that they approve the summary key objectives and performance criteria for 2007 of the Home Affairs Department, as detailed in pages 61 and 62 of the Annex to the draft Annual Business Plan 2007, and adopted an amendment of Deputy Roy George Le Hérisier of St. Saviour that in paragraph (a)(v), after the words “pages 61 and 62 of the Annex”, there be inserted the words –

– “except that in Objective 4, on page 62 of the Annex, after the words “*Sentence Planning and other programmes*” insert the words “*which will have a demonstrable impact in reducing offending behaviour.*”

THE STATES adopted, as amended, paragraph (a)(v).

### **Adjournment**

THE STATES then adjourned, having agreed to reconvene the next day, Wednesday 13th September 2006, in order to continue consideration of the proposition of the Chief Minister regarding the Annual Business Plan 2007, (P.92/2006 lodged “au Greffe” on 18th July 2006), together with the outstanding matters of public business.
