The Panel identified an apparent discrepancy between the documentation and the testimony provided by the Managing Director of The Mortgage Shop at a public hearing on 13th February 2013. It was further noted that the Scrutiny Officer awaited correspondence from a potential expert advisor, about which an update would be provided at the Panel's subsequent meeting.
