Report

The effect of the Rehabilitation of Offenders (Jersey) Law 2001 is described in the Report accompanying the Rehabilitation of Offenders (Exceptions) (Jersey) Regulations 200- (P.64/2002).

A commencement date of 1st September 2002 is proposed in order to allow employers, States' Departments and other organizations a sufficient period of time in which to review and revise their internal practices and procedures having regard to the provisions of the Law.

This draft Act has no implications for the financial or manpower resources of the States.

Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Act is to appoint 1st September 2002 as the day for the commencement of the Rehabilitation of Offenders (Jersey) Law 2001 which was adopted by the States on 7th November 2000 (P.130 of 2000).

1. The Rehabilitation of Offenders (Jersey) Law 2001 shall come into force on 1st September 2002.
2. This Act may be cited as the Rehabilitation of Offenders (Jersey) Law 2001 (Appointed Day) Act 200-.
