Maybe some people do not know how to count with out a calculator or their phone. Businesses should not be allowed refuse cash and if they do I walk away. Supermarkets are slowly moving towards card only as they will have to employ less people. I told one supermarket worker that if they went card only that I would go there every week and fill up a large trolly with food and items and go through the payment system and at the end say sorry I only have CASH. PLEASE KEEP CASH FOR US OLDER PEOPLE.
