Chief Minister: election by Island-wide vote of registered electors P.78/2017

THE STATES rejected a proposition of Deputy Russell Labey of St. Helier entitled ‘Chief Minister: election by Island-wide vote of registered electors’ (P.78/2017) that –

- (c) to charge the Privileges and Procedures Committee to bring forward for approval the necessary legislative amendments to give effect to the above proposals for implementation before the elections in May 2018.
