Explanatory Note

These draft Regulations would increase from £38 to £39 the fee payable on the first examination of a vehicle for its suitability as an omnibus or char-à-banc or (in the case of a char-à-banc that is a road train) for the suitability of each tractor or trailer of the train, and from £19 to £19.50 the fee payable for a re-examination within 30 days.

They would also increase the fees payable for applications for licences to drive public service vehicles. Where the application relates to a vehicle of a class for which the applicant has not previously held a licence, the component fees would be -

- (a) £63 instead of £61.50 for each practical test;
- (b) £50 instead of £49 for a cab driver's test on knowledge of the Island; and
- (c) £34 instead of £33 for a char-à-banc driver's test on knowledge of the Island.

In other cases, the fee would be £8.00 instead of £7.80.

The Regulations would come into force on 1st January 2001.

THE STATES, in pursuance of Articles 49A and 54 of the Motor Traffic (Jersey) Law 1935, as amended,^[1] have made the following Regulations -

1. In these Regulations, “principal Regulations” means the Public Service Vehicles (Fees) (Jersey) Regulations 1991,^[2] as amended.^[3]
2. For the scale of fees in Regulation 1 of the principal Regulations there shall be substituted the following scale of fees -

<i>“Class of vehicle</i>	<i>Fee</i>
Omnibus.....	£39
Char-à-banc, being a road train within the meaning of the Law, for each motor tractor or trailer.....	£39
Any other char-à-banc.....	£39
Cab.....	£38”.

3. In Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations -
 - (a) in sub-paragraph (a)(A), for the amount “£61.50” there shall be substituted the amount “£63”;
 - (b) in sub-paragraph (a)(B), for the amount “£49” there shall be substituted the amount “£50”;
 - (c) in sub-paragraph (a)(C), for the amount “£33” there shall be substituted the amount “£34”;
 - (d) in sub-paragraph (b), for the amount “£7.80” there shall be substituted the amount “£8.00”.
4. The Public Service Vehicles (Fees) (Amendment No. 10) (Jersey) Regulations 1999^[4] shall be repealed.

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Vehicles (Fees) (Amendment No. 11) (Jersey) Regulations 2000 and shall come into force on the first day of January 2001.
