Piquet House: cancellation of sale and future use – P.16/2014

THE STATES, adopting a proposition of Deputy John Hilary Young of St. Brelade, requested the Minister for Treasury and Resources –

- (a) not to proceed with the sale of Piquet House, Royal Square, St. Helier as proposed in the Report presented to the States by the Minister in accordance with the provisions of Standing Order 168 on 29th January 2014;
- (b) to investigate and implement suitable alternative uses of the premises for public or community purposes which were compatible with the strategic location of the premises in the Royal Square, including their leasing to community organisations; provided that, if no suitable alternative public or community use could be identified within 12 months, the Minister should offer a lease of the building for commercial purposes, subject to restrictive conditions to ensure the building was conserved and that its future use was compatible with its historic location in the Royal Square.
