	3. <b>Draft Scoping Document and Budget</b> a) Scoping Document Background to the review was discussed. Housing's plan requires an exemption from accepted procedure to retain proceeds of asset sales within the Department, rather than returning to the States. Legal input will be needed on this. An additional objective was agreed to reflect the need to look into this aspect of the plan.	
	It was noted that Rent Rebate figures more or less equal rents received from States tenants; this has led to the Treasury agreeing £6m p.a. towards maintenance costs. The financial position of Housing is unsustainable. Rent Rebate now to come under Social Security.	
	The risk of time-overrun on the review was discussed. It was felt the review should not be rushed given the understanding that the Social Housing Property Plan was a year in preparation.
