This Order adds to the list of proscribed organizations set out in the Terrorism (Jersey) Law 2002 the name Jama'at ud Da'wa (as an ancillary name for Lashkar e Tayyaba) and the Somali organization Al Shabaab.

The Order was made on 21st May 2010 and comes into force on 28th May 2010.
