

Bag Limits</b></p> <p>The Panel further considered the evidence that it had gathered during the course of its review following its concluding Public Hearing with the Connétable of St Clement, Assistant Minister for Economic Development.</p> <p>The Panel considered the drafting process for its report and it was agreed that an initial draft would be forwarded by the officer ahead of the Panel's scheduled meeting on Monday 6th July 2009. The Panel was advised by the Scrutiny officer that there was a short timescale remaining in order for its report to be drafted and finalised in line with the Code of Practice in time for presentation to the States ahead of the scheduled debate of Bag Limits Regulations on 13th July 2009.</p>	<b>TO</b>

Depositor Compensation</b></p> <p>The Panel was advised that four background information files had been received by the Scrutiny Officer, in confidence as policy in development, from the Department of Economic Development. The Department had requested that the documents were not to be released to the Panel until confidentiality agreements had been signed. The Chairman informed the Panel that he had signed a confidentiality agreement on his own behalf in order that he could begin to examine the files and advise the Panel accordingly. He advised the Panel that he did not believe that all of the documentation that he had viewed so far should be classified as confidential. The Chairman would further update the Panel after consideration of the remaining files.</p> <p>The Panel considered its draft scoping and Terms of Reference for its review, which were approved subject to agreed minor amendments.</p>	<b>MH</b>
