THE STATES, in pursuance of Article 3 of the "Lois (1885 à 1940) touchant l'Administration des Marchés Publics", have made the following Regulations -

- 1. Notwithstanding paragraph (1) of Regulation 4 of the Public Markets (Administration) (Jersey) Regulations 1947,² as amended,³ the Markets in the Town of Saint Helier shall not be open to the public on Saturday, the twenty-sixth day of December 1998.
- 2. The Public Markets (Administration) (Supplementary Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1993⁴ are repealed.
- 3. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Markets (Administration) (Supplementary Provisions) (Jersey) Regulations 1998 and shall come into force on promulgation.
