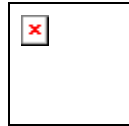

Report

On 7th July 1992 the States, adopting a proposition of Senator R.J. Shenton, “agreed to establish a Consultative Panel of elected members of the States with whom the Bailiff would be able to meet in order to consult on a confidential basis in appropriate cases”.

The States agreed that the Panel would comprise -

- the senior Senator
- the senior Connétable
- the senior Deputy
- the President of the Policy and Resources Committee
- the President of the Finance and Economics Committee
- the President of the Establishment (now Human Resources) Committee and three members appointed by the States

Following the recent elections the ex officio members of the Panel are -

- President, Policy and Resources Committee (Senator P.F. Horsfall)
- President, Finance and Economics Committee (Senator F.H. Walker)
- President, Human Resources Committee (Deputy D.L. Crespel)
- senior Senator (J.A. Le Maistre) in place of Senator Horsfall
- senior Connétable (St. Mary)
- senior Deputy (H.H. Baudains)

The States now need to appoint three members to serve on the Panel and I have pleasure in proposing -

- Deputy Alan Breckon
- Deputy Paul Routier

who were members of the Panel as previously constituted, and Senator Corrie Stein.
